KCDA is leading the way with new contracts ...

According to Washington STEM, a nonprofit organization dedicated to advancing science, technology, engineering, and math education, Washington State will see a 24% increase in STEM jobs by 2018. Demand for jobs in aerospace, computer science, and health care are paving the way for new schools across the state like Northwest Career and Technology in Mount Vernon, Columbia Basin Skills Center in Moses Lake, HeLa High School in Vancouver, Science and Math Institute in Tacoma, Clark County Skills Center in Vancouver, and Aviation High School in Seattle. Today's learning environment is changing and KCDA is leading the way with new contracts that provide access to STEM education across the state.

KCDA's contract with Laerdal Patient Care Equipment has provided a vehicle for schools like HeLa High and Seattle Community College to purchase patient simulators that facilitate training in CPR, resuscitation, and handling trauma victims. Our contract with Klein Educational Systems provided a vehicle for Clark County Skills Center to purchase avionics and robotic equipment needed to train students in aviation technology and industrial robotics. Other Klein equipment on contract provides students with access to the technical skills needed to become manufacturing operators, quality control specialists, and process control engineers. Our contracts with A-L Compressed Gases, Ellis Machinery, and OMAX provided a much easier way for Columbia Basin Skills Center to purchase a CNC Lathe, a Water Jet Cutter, and other specialized hydraulic equipment required to train students in automotive technology and advanced manufacturing. KCDA understands the time commitment for school districts to bid these items direct and remains committed to providing contracts that improve STEM instruction throughout the state.



For more than 70 years, KCDA has been a leader in providing centralized procurement services to our member school districts. KCDA helps districts focus their resources in the classrooms by creating volume purchasing and fulfilling bid law requirements. KCDA operates as an extension of your purchasing department, governed by the basic laws and regulations that apply to all school districts in Washington. Every dollar spent using our contracts increases our purchasing power and helps us get lower pricing to our member districts. More importantly, you can be assured that our contracts are safe, legal, and compliant. KCDA is audited annually and we have enjoyed clean audits for the past 12 years.
