

SECTION 6: HEALTH HAZARD DATA

ROUTES OF ENTRY/SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF EXPOSURE: **ACUTE:** Eyes: liquid and vapors may cause mild irritation. Skin: prolonged or repeated contact can cause dryness, irritation, dermatitis. Inhalation: mists or vapors may cause nose and respiratory irritation, headache, nausea, dizziness. Breathing small amounts during normal handling is not likely to cause harmful effects. Vapor concentrations (greater than recommended exposure limits) may cause unconsciousness and other central nervous system effects. Ingestion: low toxicity. Causes irritation of the stomach and intestines, resulting in nausea or vomiting. Aspiration of ingested or vomited liquid into the lungs may cause chemical pneumonia which can be fatal.

CHRONIC EFFECTS: None known.

CARCINOGENS: None listed under OSHA, IARC, EPA or NTP.

MEDICAL CONDITIONS AGGRAVATED BY EXPOSURE: Pre-existing respiratory or skin disorders.

EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES: Eyes: immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while holding eyelids open to ensure complete rinsing. Promptly remove contact lenses if worn. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Skin: immediately flush with plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Get medical attention if irritation develops or persists. Inhalation: remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Get medical attention. Ingestion: if large quantities of this material are swallowed, CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless directed to do so by a physician. May cause aspiration pneumonia. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

SECTION 7: PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES: Eliminate all ignition sources. Ventilate area and use appropriate protective equipment. **SMALL SPILLS:** Mop up or soak up immediately. Remove residue outdoors or to a ventilation hood. **LARGE SPILLS:** Dike to contain liquid, reclaim all possible. Absorb remainder on inert material and place in closed containers. Keep out of drains, sewers, streams or other bodies of water.

WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD: **DANGER:** Contains petroleum distillate. Dispose of in accordance with Federal, State and local regulations. If disposed of as received, product is regulated as an ignitable hazardous waste (D001) under RCRA.

HANDLING AND STORING: Combustible liquid and vapor. Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid breathing vapors. Do not store or handle near heat, sparks, flame or strong oxidants. Observe proper grounding procedures to prevent fire hazard from static accumulation and discharge. Vapors are heavier than air and may tend to collect in low or poorly ventilated areas resulting in possible fire and/or inhalation hazard. Store only in original container and keep closed. Do not reuse empty container.

OTHER PRECAUTIONS: Keep away children. Read and follow label directions. Minimize exposure to liquids, vapors, mists or fumes.

SECTION 8: CONTROL MEASURES

VENTILATION: General mechanical and/or local exhaust as needed to maintain below exposure limits. Required when spraying large amounts or applying in confined area. Use non-sparking equipment. No smoking or open lights.

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION: None required in normal use of this product as per label directions.

GLOVES: Nitrile rubber or plastic.

EYE PROTECTION: Chemical safety glasses or goggles as needed if contact likely.

OTHER PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: Impervious clothing and boots if required to prevent prolonged or repeated skin contact.

WORK/HYGIENIC PRACTICES: Avoid prolonged or repeated skin contact. Wash skin thoroughly after handling. Do not wear clothing soaked with product. Air-dry in a well-ventilated area, then launder before reuse.
