



The Washington State Vision Screening Kit for 2017 Guidelines were created by Good-Lite and School Health based on the requirements established by the Washington State Board of Health for Elementary, Middle, and High School vision screening.



Level 1: Kindergarten and Grade One

- 20/40 critical line screening flipbook at 5 feet for Kindergarten
- 20/32 critical line screening flipbook at 5 feet for Grade One
- Fun Frames* Occluders, use up to age 10 years
- 20 Adhesive Eye Patches
- LEA SYMBOLS® Near Vision Screener Chart with 16" cord
- Instructions, Recording form, Lap card and Individual cards for matching

Level 2: Grades Two and Above

- Sloan Letters, Proportional-spaced, Distance Chart at 10 feet
- Sloan Letters, Proportional-spaced, Near Vision Chart with 16" cord
- Fun Frames* Occluders, use up to age 10 years
- Spectacle Occluder, ages 10 years and older
