Procurement Services That Save You Time and Money

KCDA Student Supply Program!

Prior to the start of each school year children across the northwest are given lists of school supplies for their parents to buy (such as pencils, colored markers, glue sticks, etc.) to send to school with their child at the start of the school year. KCDA's "Student Supply" program offers students, parents and schools a cost effective purchase option for these supplies that ensures every student, regardless of their parents ability to pay, starts the school year with a full set of supplies requested for their grade level.

The concept behind the KCDA "Student Supply" program is very straightforward. Schools provide KCDA with a list of school supplies needed for children in their school by grade level. KCDA procures these supplies at competitive prices through our vendor-partners and ships supplies in bulk, by grade level, to each designated school location. Schools receiving these supplies then "kit" these supplies for each student (using their PTA, parents or other volunteers time) and charge parents a nominal fee, based on ability to pay, to offset the cost of purchasing these supplies in for their children.

KCDA's "Student Supply" program offers benefits to Students, Parents and Schools:

Students benefit from this program by having them all start the new school year with the exact same set of high quality school supplies, regardless of their families economic situation.

Parents benefit by not having to shop or search online seeking student supply items for their child. When parents seek out student supplies they often don't know which items are quality products and may buy whatever is the cheapest. By offering parents the KCDA "School Supply" program schools ensure that the supplies their children are using are affordable and are of good quality.

Schools benefit from this program as it ensures equity in having each child equally prepared for the start of the school year with the same set of high quality school supplies. KCDA's "Student Supply" program allows schools the ability to customize their supply lists based on teacher preferences and to control the number and quality of the items purchased.

Program Cost – Schools may choose to charge parents a variable fee for this program based on their family's ability to pay. For example: a school might charge \$30.00 per student for families that can afford it, \$10.00 for those from lower income homes and extend a "No Charge" program offering if a family cannot afford to purchase student supplies for their child.



Here's how our program works:

- KCDA procures and inventories high-quality, cost-competitive student supplies and makes them available to schools from our Kent, WA distribution facility.
- Upon receiving student supply orders, KCDA packs and ships the student supplies to each school location. Student Supply materials can be ordered and shipped by grade level to facilitate easier distribution.
- School staff and parent volunteers receive the student supplies and create Student Supply kits. (Available kit options include boxes, Ziploc plastic bags or backpacks).

Ordering Your 2021 School Supplies

We recommend getting your orders into KCDA as early as possible. The KCDA purchasing team bases its buying from your new orders and also from your previous years orders. Receiving your order helps to maintain sufficient inventory to cover the needs of every member. Not sure where to start? Try the "Reorder from History" option as described below.

When placing your school start up order be certain to indicate when you want your orders delivered. August to mid September have the busiest delivery dates and tend fill up fast, requested delivery dates are on on a first come first serve basis.

Reorder from History

Here are the instructions for the new KCDA "Reorder From History" button on the KCDA homepage. This feature allows you to create a cart from items you have previously ordered (for example; last year's startup order). This feature is based on the Items Order Summary report which saves you from having to go through old carts or orders looking for a KCDA item # that you previously ordered. You can now create a cart and add items from this report.

- 1. Sign on to the KCDA website.
- 2. Click on "Reorder From History" in the menu > leave the report set on Items Order Summary Report.
- 3. Click the "Ship To" field and click in the box for your school or dept. Usually the school is the only one that shows. (close that menu to see the next field).
- 4. Click the "Status" field and click in the box for completed. (close that menu to see the next field).
- 5. To do a startup order, click previous on the "from" date to a date that would include your 19-20 startup order. You might go back to 4/1/2019 for instance. I usually select the current date for the "to" date.
- 6. Click "GO". You will generate an alpha list of all items ordered during that time period complete with KCDA item numbers.
- 7. To select all items on the report, click in the box at the top of the list in the header and all line items will turn green. To select individual items, click the box for each line item you want and it will turn green. At the bottom of this alpha list, you will find one of two buttons. You will see an "Add Selected Items to Cart" if you already have an open cart. If there is no open cart, you will see "Create and Add All" to set up your cart. Clicking either "add" button will populate a cart (this may take a couple of minutes if your order is large). When the process is completed, you will see a lot of orange stripes that notify you of price changes. Ignore that and scroll to the top of the screen. Click on your cart in the field just to the left of the "Options" button.

You can now edit your cart by changing amounts & clicking update, hitting the red 'X' to delete items, adding account codes & clicking update, and add items by shopping.






