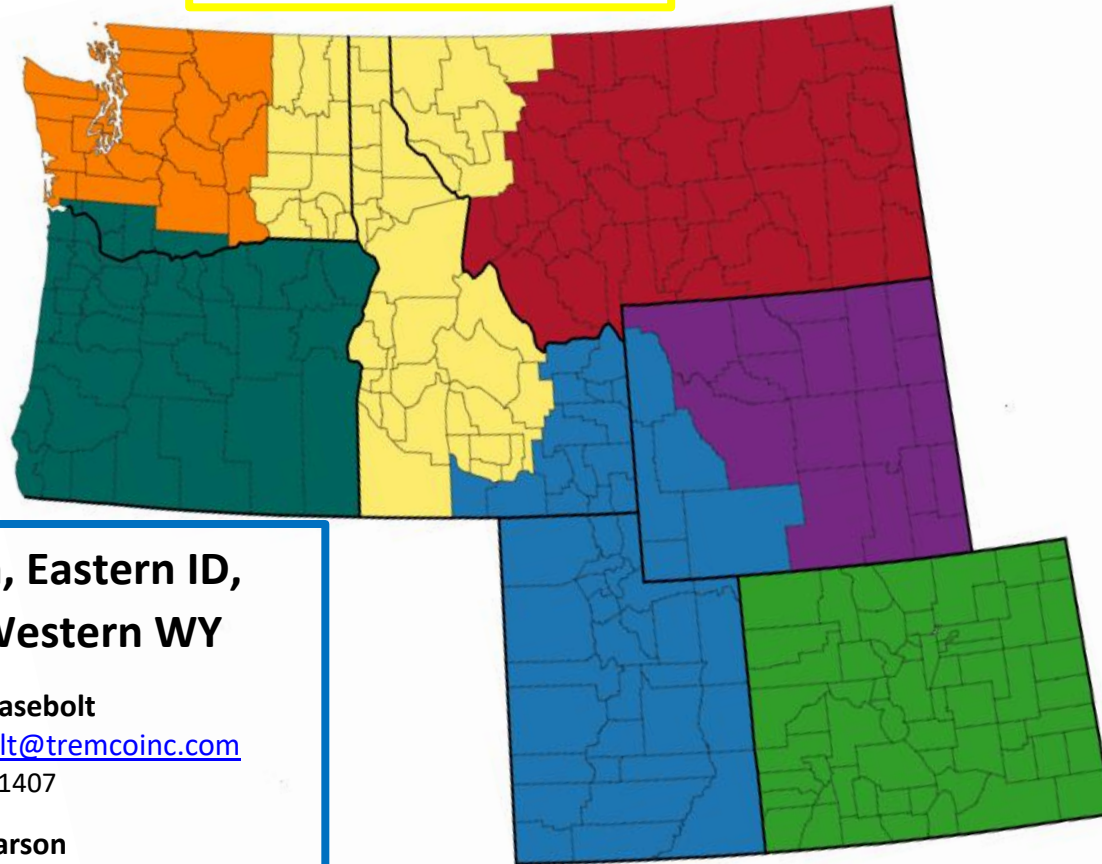

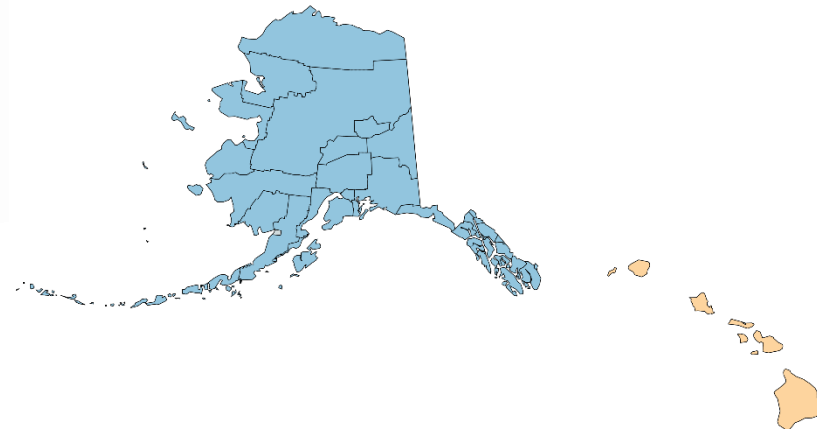

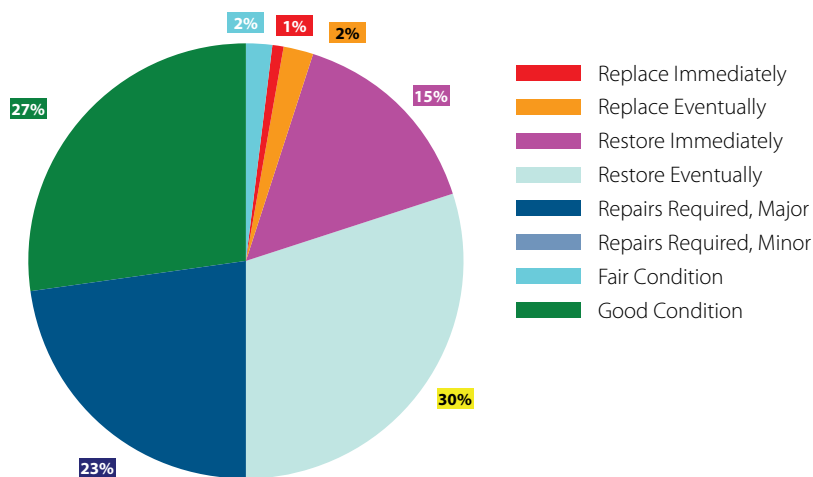

PHASE 1 The facts. Know what you have.

PHASE 2 The plan. Match priorities to budgets.
