Director's Corner

How does the AEPA bid process work?

AEPA is comprised of lead agencies from 29 member states and KCDA is AEPA's lead (member) agency for Washington. But, how does the AEPA bid process work?

First, AEPA assigns an oversight committee made up of K-12 peers to a specific bidding category (such as office supplies, instructional materials, or security solutions). With the assistance of an expert consultant, the oversight committee studies the bidding category and identifies possible vendors.

Then, the oversight committee puts bid terms, conditions, specifications, and evaluation procedures into a bid document. Any category-specific terms are merged into a package with general legal terms and conditions common to all participating agencies. The oversight committee loads the bid solicitation package into an electronic bidding platform, which is then distributed to hundreds — if not thousands — of potential bidders. Concurrently, each of the participating AEPA member agencies places bidding advertisements in newspapers within their jurisdictions to encourage submissions and comply with state laws.

After that, vendor companies submit bids electronically, and a separate bid committee evaluates bidders' paperwork before turning in correctly completed documents to the respective oversight committees. The oversight committees evaluate all bids on specification compliance and price and then submit their results to the full AEPA board. Board members vote to make formal award contract recommendations to the respective state-level agencies.

Next, individual state members consider the AEPA board's recommendations. If they believe the recommended bidders meet their state laws, rules, and regulations, they bring the bids to their local agency boards for a formal contract award. Each state member executes paperwork to implement the contract according to specific procedures. The awarding state agency and vendor work together to promote contract usage within the state.

Awarded vendors and state agencies report sales to AEPA quarterly. Likewise, contracts are reviewed yearly for performance and sales volume. Those that receive positive recommendations by the oversight committee are eligible for a one-year renewal in all AEPA state jurisdictions.

As a founding member of AEPA, KCDA members have access to the best national contracts available for administrative software, athletics, carpeting, copiers, furniture, groundskeeping, lighting, musical instruments, playground, roofing, synthetic turf and track surfaces, scoreboards, and vehicles. Since KCDA is owned by Washington's Public-School Districts, every dollar spent using AEPA contracts through KCDA increases our purchasing power and helps us get lower pricing to our members. More importantly, the dollars spent stay in the Northwest instead of ending up in some other part of the country.

Check Out Your Cart Reminder



Every September, KCDA will get calls from personnel checking on the status of their orders. Upon reviewing, we discover that the order was created, but the cart was not “checked” out. If you use Skyward, you need to “punch” out your order.

Please remember to check out your active carts to avoid delays in receiving your back-to-school orders. This will help insure that KCDA has adequate stock on hand to fill your orders for the start of the year.

KCDA will schedule your order to deliver according to the delivery date requested when you check out your cart. August is our busiest time and delivery times fill up fast. If you could take receipt of your order in June or July, this is a less hectic time for us and shipping companies.

Receiving Your KCDA Order

Please check your carton count when you receive your order using the included packing slip. If your packing slip is missing, please call KCDA Customer Service, and we can send you a new copy.

When you are checking your supplies, please look for shortages, overages, or damage, and make notes of any issue on the freight carriers delivery receipt (Bill of Lading). Please contact KCDA directly so that we can fulfill your order.

KCDA accepts returns at no charge within twenty business days of receipt or by September 30th for Summer deliveries. Returns requested after these deadlines will be charged return freight and a 10% restocking fee. Expired products are not eligible for return. KCDA only considers returns that are supported by KCDA records and paperwork.

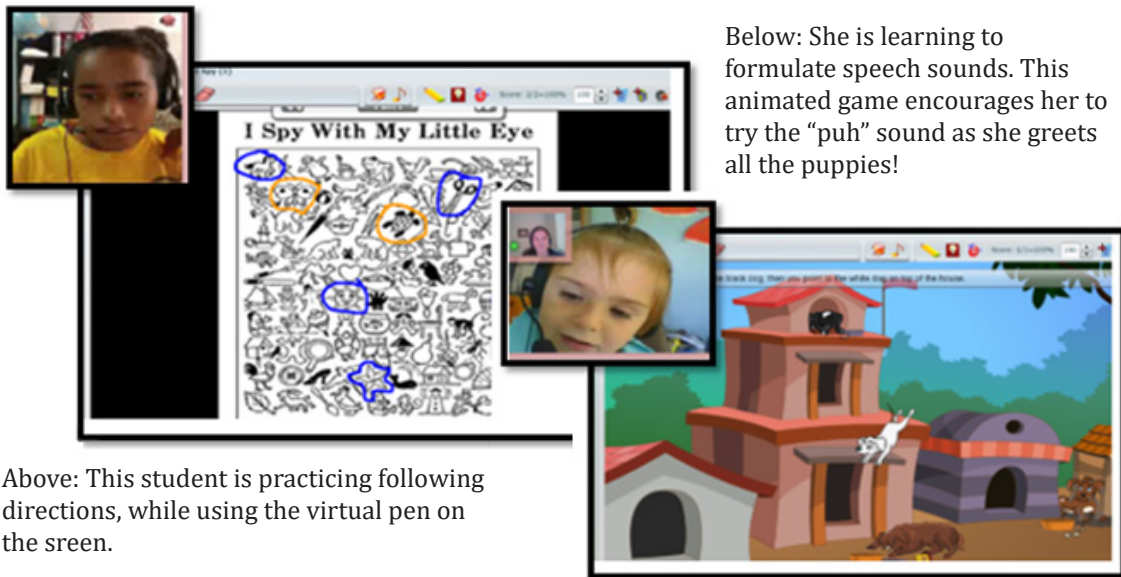

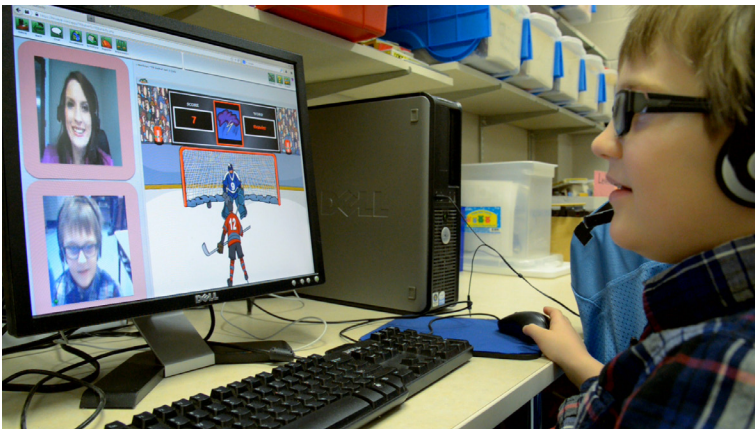
