KCDA is fortunate to own its 170,000 square foot warehouse and doesn't have rent or mortgage expenses. We maintain millions of dollars of inventory spanning over 15,000 items. We maintain this inventory to provide products to our members when needed. Members benefit from short lead times, reduced need for their own warehouse space, and by not having funds tied up in inventory.

Our dedicated purchasing department manages over 80 contract categories. Our knowledgeable contract specialists develop specifications and bid documents, locally advertise, evaluate and award bids, and manage and renew contracts with vendors. They ensure compliance with the public bid process to meet the buying requirements of its members. Together with a customer service team that truly listens to our members, we are able to offer contracts that matter to our members and add new categories when needed.

KCDA is also a founding member of the Association of Educational Purchasing Agencies (AEPA). Through AEPA, 29 state purchasing cooperatives leverage their resources and buying power to deliver value to their members. While most KCDA contracts are developed in-house, AEPA contracts offer an expanded selection and additional savings for KCDA's members.

Lastly, the KCDA team is uniquely committed to serving its members. KCDA doesn't exist to earn a profit or reach a sales goal. It exists to serve its members by providing the products they need at competitive prices and lead times while simplifying and complying with the public procurement process. Our people each understand how they contribute to our members' success.







## 2022 Was Mixed Year From A Procurement Standpoint

We still experienced supply chain disruptions until Q3 2022, but then there was a gradual improvement in Q4: a few vendors dropped their product price and there was also an improvement in their delivery lead time.

Another positive side of the coin is that our vendors strengthened their performance fundamentals as they survived the harsh industry environment.

Internally, KCDA Purchasing continued to develop new contract categories and renew well performing contracts in 2022 to serve our members better. KCDA manages total 83 contract categories via formal bid or awarding AEPA (Association of Educational Purchasing Agencies) contract.

## **VENDOR HIGHLIGHT**

## Pacific Mobile Structures, Portable and Modular Buildings Contract 255

Pacific Mobile Structures, a KCDA multi-year Top Vendor, sells and leases exceptional mobile office space and builds innovative modular structures with a relentless, customer-first commitment. They recently completed a modular project for KCDA member North Thurston School District's Aspire Middle School, who needed space for their STEM program. Limited on space with their existing buildings and aging 28x32 modulars, North Thurston needed to upgrade and expand their facilities in a way that would not disrupt the residential neighborhood directly behind their property.

With a 10-year partnership history, North Thurston turned to Pacific Mobile Structures for a 10,472-square-foot building to house three cutting-edge science laboratories, two math classrooms, and one robotics laboratory complete with laboratory prep areas and storage rooms. The building was placed on the back corner of the school lot and designed to maximize the footprint based on the constraints of the property lines of the site.
