



# K12 Funding Reference Guide

This guide provides schools and district's identifiable uses funding for Kajeet Connectivity Solutions.



## ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Act) Title Funds

Title funds are federal dollars that are meant to supplement existing state funding for education. Title funds are released yearly, and the amount awarded to State Educational Agencies (SEAs) and Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) is determined either through the use of an established formula or a competitive grant application.

### Title I, Part A: College & Career Ready

#### What is it? Who is it for?

- The Title I section of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) is specifically targeted toward children in poverty. It is the largest federal program supporting elementary and secondary education.

#### What can it be used for?

- Examples of services that may be funded by Title I include after-school programs, ELL student support, technology initiatives (i.e. purchasing laptops, tablets, etc), and professional development for Title I

### Title I, Part C: Migrant Education Program

#### What is it? Who is it for?

- Migrant education program (MEP) funds support high-quality education programs that meet the special needs of migratory children to help them succeed academically.

#### What can it be used for?

- Examples of services that may be funded by Title I include after-school programs, ELL student support, technology initiatives (i.e. purchasing laptops, tablets, etc), and professional development for Title I staff.

### Title III, Part A: English Language Learner (ELL)

#### What is it? Who is it for?

- Title III, Part A: ELL funds are used to help children attain English proficiency and meet a state's academic content and student academic achievement standards.

#### What can it be used for?

- These funds may be partially used to provide community participation programs, family literacy services, and parent outreach and training activities to limited English proficient children and their families, as well as home-school Internet connections.

### Title IV, Part A: Student Support & Academic Enrichment

#### What is it? Who is it for?

- Provide students with access to a well-rounded education by improving school conditions, and expand the use of technology to support learning and academic achievement

#### What can it be used for?

- Technology purchases; STEM programs; school improvement projects; nutritional programs

### Title VI: Rural Education Achievement Program (REAP)

#### What is it? Who is it for?

- The Title VI: Rural Education Achievement Program (REAP) is designed to help small, rural districts use federal resources more effectively.

#### What can it be used for?

- REAP funding may be used towards initiatives meant to improve student outcomes, such as family literacy programs, purchasing devices and software for digital learning, educator recruitment, and improving

## Title IX, Part A: McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act

### What is it? Who is it for?

- The provision for homeless children and youths of before- and after-school, mentoring, and summer programs in which a teacher or other qualified individual provides tutoring, homework assistance, and supervision of educational activities.

### What can it be used for?

- McKinney-Vento authorizes state boards of education to make grants to local education agencies for the purposes of facilitating the enrollment, attendance, and success of children and youth experiencing homelessness.

## ESSER (Elementary & Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund)

The U.S. Government has set aside over \$190 billion in stimulus funding for schools in the form of federal COVID-19 relief funds.

### ARP Act (American Rescue Plan Act)

\$126 billion in ESSER funds to be distributed nationwide to K-12 education. Funds need be expended by September 30, 2024.

### What can it be used for?

- Distance/Remote Learning (software); Supplemental Learning; Summer Enrichment; After School Programs; At-Risk Populations

## Strengthening Career & Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V)

Federal act established to improve career-technical education programs, integrate academic and career-technical instruction, serve special populations, and meet gender equity needs.

### What can Perkins CTE Act funds be used for?

- Provide career exploration and career development activities (including in the middle grades)
- CTE programs and programs of study
- Expanding access to career and technical education for special populations
