In the National Toxicology Program's (NTP) 7th Annual Report on Carcinogens (1994), respirable glasswool was classified as reasonably anticipated to be carcinogenic. OSHA considers fibrous glass dust a nuisance dust. Fibrous glass can cause dermatitis, local irritation.
